5.Skype

An older app, compatible with all devices and platforms. At first Skype was used as a messaging app but now used for 1 on 1 or group meetings with video and voice, so long as everyone has a **webcam and a microphone**.

6. Signal (Editor's favourite)

Signal is a newer app. It is a free, privacy-focussed messaging and voice talk app you can use on Apple or Android. You can send direct or group messages, **photos** and voice messages. The key advantage of Signal over 1-5 is a strong focus on security and privacy.

Now favoured by tech giants, cyber security experts, journalists, government officials and Elon Musk!

Signal user messages are <u>stored only on your device</u>, not on Signal servers or anywhere else. No way for a hacker to read your message by hacking Signal's infrastructure. (Ever careful, your editor still won't text a password or bank information on Signal)
