- Delivery right to your kitchen avoid heavy lifting

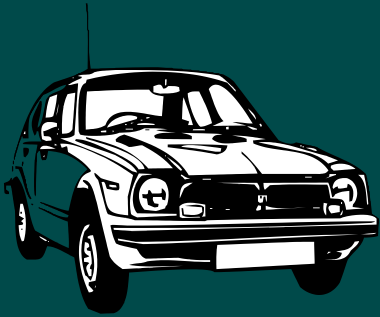

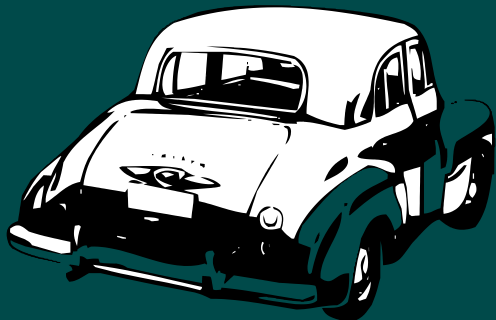

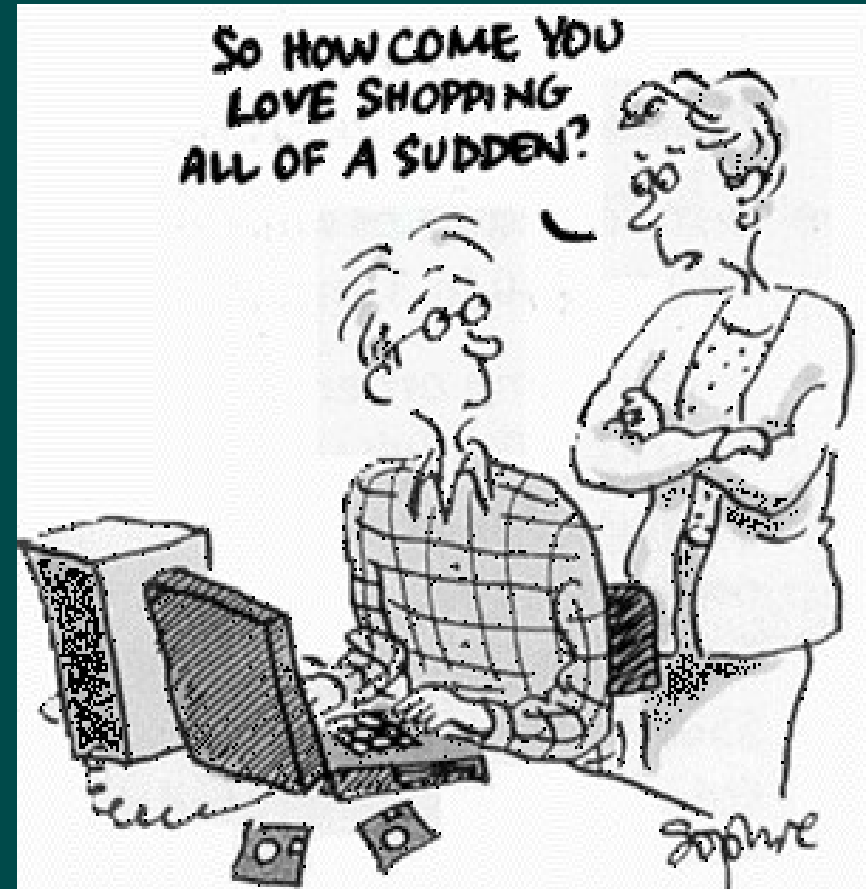

- Key the Reference number (from the bill)
- Key the amount
- Record the receipt number you are given
